

Health and Safety PolicyStatement

Sight 2020 Directstaff, volunteers, project partners, trustees, grantees and contractors work within the UK and Malawi.

Our Health and Safety statement is to:

- Prevent accidents and causes of work-related illness
- Manage health and safety risks whilst working from home by:
 - Adhering to best practice to maximise safety i.e. taking regular breaks when working at the computer, maintaining correct posture, having ergonomic chair and equipment
 - Ensuring that there is adequate lighting and ventilation in areas of work
 - Reducing the risk of fires by ensuring that all papers and other flammable items are stored safety away after use
 - Ensuring that homes have fire alarms and smoke detectors
 - Minimising the risk of trips and falls by ensuring that electrical cables and cords are neatly put away at all times
- o Ensure safe use and handling of substances
- Review and revise the policy regularly
- Ensure the safety and well-being of all our staff, volunteers, project partners, trustees, grantees and contractors. This has recently been demonstrated during the COVID-19 pandemic when our charity supported our partners in Malawi by providing personal protection equipment (PPE), hand sanitisers, hand washing stations within our partner school premises etc.
- Encourage all our staff, volunteers, project partners, trustees, grantees and contractors with the UK
 and Malawi to adhere to government guidelines with regards to COVID-19 by adhering to various
 lock-down measure, maintaining social distancing measures, wearing face coverings, engaging in
 appropriate hand-washing measures etc to reduce the risk of spreading or contracting COVID-19.
- Promote adherence to manufacturer guidance and guidelines when handling substances i.e.glue, paint etc or operating equipment i.e. photocopiers, guillotines etc.
- Risk assessments are completed regularly to minimise risk
- Whilst working with local schools in Malawi we ensure that our safety policies are adhered to and adapted to suit specific sport and art related activities
